The workshop will consist of lectures by renowned senior engineers, and design presentations by participating young engineers. Participants are required to conceive a design of a footbridge which fits a designated construction site and submit the design by a deadline (April 30, 2015) together with the application form. In the workshop, participants will get comments from senior engineers after presenting the concepts of their designs. Excellent designs will be awarded. After the workshop, all participants are invited to join a get-together party.

The Finnish Group of IABSE together with Finnish Association of Civil Engineers RIL organised the IABSE Workshop 2015 in Helsinki from February 11-12, 2015. The event assembled 63 participants from 21 countries. The theme of the Workshop 'Safety, Robustness and Condition Assessments of Structures' was the continuation of the 2013 Workshop arranged at the same venue. The Workshop consisted on five invited keynote presentations by P. In order to commemorate Prof. Magnel's exceptional achievements, the Association of Engineers of Ghent University (AIG) bestows this medal every fifth year to the designer of a structure, which is deemed to be an important and remarkable application of reinforced or prestressed concrete.
