The 19th Congress of IABSE 'Challenges in Design and Construction of an Innovative and Sustainable Built Environment' will be held from September 21-23, 2016. It will be hosted by the Swedish Group of IABSE, in co-operation with the Swedish Transport Administration and the Swedish Professionals for Built Environment. The Scientific Committee is chaired by Lennart Elfgren from Luleå University of Technology and the Organising Committee is chaired by Mats Karlsson from the Swedish Transportation Administration.

[Scientific Sessions](#) will give an opportunity to present research results, new technical developments, interesting project presentations, lessons learnt and future expectations. 6. News From Members

- **Ian Firth, UK** - Bridges to Prosperity launched its UK Charitable Trust in July and is already gaining considerable support from companies in the UK and the rest of Europe. The charity works with local communities in remote rural areas of developing countries to provide bridges giving access to schools, markets, medical centres and other facilities. Ian Firth has been appointed as Chairman of the UK Trust which is focussing efforts on building bridges in Africa. He has recently returned from Rwanda where a team of engineers from Flint & Neill and Balfour Beatty constructed a 50m suspension bridge for the Gaseke community north of Kigali. - **Ahsan Kareem, USA** - the Robert M. Moran Professor of Engineering has received 2015 ASCE's the Theodore von Karman Medal at the 2015 EMI Conference held late June at Stanford University. The award was made in recognition for his fundamental contributions to the quantification, modeling, simulation and analysis of dynamic load effects, and its application in aerodynamics in civil engineering, in the best forward looking tradition of Theodore von Karman.
